

20 Night Driving

Task Requirements

Demonstrate safe and controlled driving appropriate to night/dark driving conditions.

Task Key Points

Ensures that all vehicle lights (front and rear) are in proper working order.

Always turns on the vehicle's low-beam headlights when driving at night.

Uses high-beam headlights when appropriate, dipping to low-beam within 200 metres of another vehicle.

When being overtaken, dips headlights to low-beam when the overtaking vehicle is next to your vehicle.

When overtaking, switch to high-beam headlights when next to and level with the other vehicle, when appropriate

Adjusts the internal rear vision mirror to reduce glare from following vehicle's headlights when appropriate.

To avoid being dazzled by another vehicle's headlights, demonstrate the ability to look to the front left of the road and keep the vehicle to the left of the road.

If dazzled by another vehicle's headlights, demonstrate the ability to slow down and, if necessary, stop in a safe position until vision is recovered.

Recognises how reflective signs, markings and delineators can help guide drivers in low light conditions.
